



## CPSC General Compliance Statement

Pursuant to the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), effective February 8, 2013, the requirements outlined in *16 Code of Federal Regulations §1107 Testing and Labeling Pertaining to Product Certification* must be followed. The requirements of Certificates of Compliance (COC) are also covered in this document. While the importer is to issue the two types of COCs—General Certificates of Conformity (GCC) and Children’s Product Certificates (CPC)—when Meijer is the importer Meijer requires the testing laboratory and/or manufacturer to provide the required supporting information as part of the Post-Production Approval process to enable Meijer to do so.

In addition to producing the appropriate test reports, the vendor is also required to complete the Certificate of Compliance template. Based on purchase order information, Meijer will notify the vendor and/or manufacturer of the products requiring a COC approximately 30-60 days prior to the ship date. Note that if items on the purchase order are cancelled or added after Meijer’s initial notice to the vendor, it is the responsibility of the vendor to communicate changes to [cpSC@meijer.com](mailto:cpSC@meijer.com).

For higher risk products, additional testing and/or warning statements may be required under CPSC’s Federal Hazardous Substances Act (FHSA), Flammable Fabrics Act (FFA), or Poison Prevention Packaging Act (PPPA). Safety Data Sheets (SDS) are also required to be submitted for all formulated products in the Hardlines/Home area. Meijer expects manufacturers to comply with all required regulations and standards applicable to the products produced for Meijer, including those under the authority of the CPSC.
